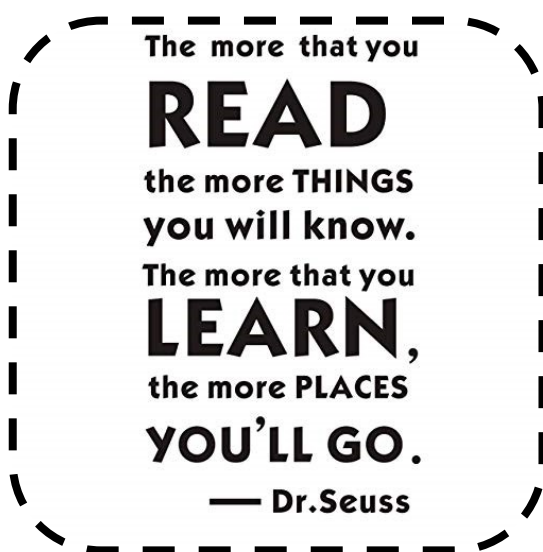




MICHELAGO PUBLIC SCHOOL

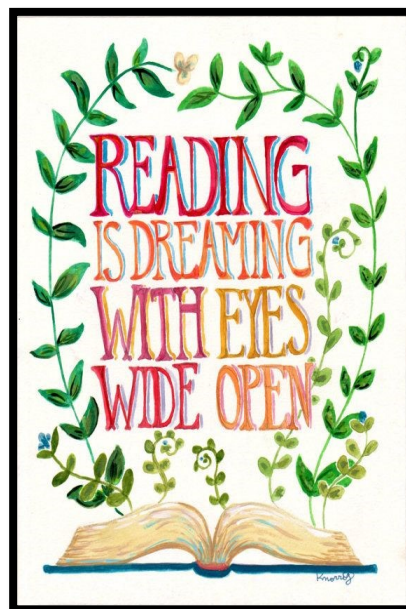

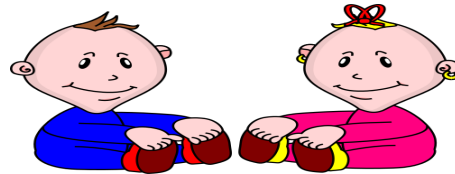

Next time you are planning to throw your bottle cap away, think twice as it can be used to make prosthetics for children using 3D technology.

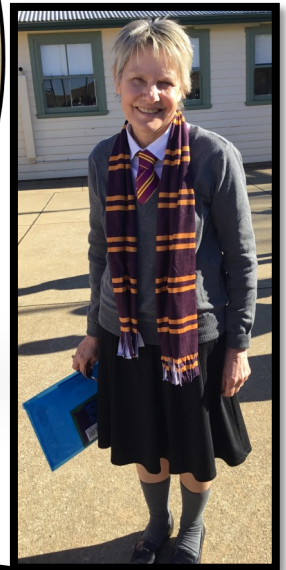
